Dear Parent(s),

Congratulations! We are happy to inform you that your child has been selected for the next phase in the model selection process for the 2012 American Girl Fashion Show benefiting the Child Advocacy Center. While your child initially meets the criteria for being a model for the fashion show, the final model selections will depend on the actual fittings of the American Girl fashions, which are due to arrive in mid-February.

Once the clothing arrives from American Girl, you will be contacted with the date of your child's fitting session which we expect to hold around mid-late February. At your child's scheduled fitting she will try on the clothing that American Girl has assigned for the doll your child has been selected to model. We cannot make any alterations to the clothing; therefore this fitting is the only way to confirm that she can in fact model the assigned clothing in the fashion show. Although occasionally the initial measurements for a model are off and the clothing sent will not work for the selected model, it is not common and we do our best to make sure all girls selected in phase one will model something in a show.

In addition to the fashion fitting, the other requirement for your daughter to model in the fashion show is the fulfillment of the sponsorship agreement, which includes raising a minimum of \$50.00 in sponsorships and selling a minimum of \$50.00 in raffle tickets. There will be prizes awarded for the three models that raise the most money in sponsorships (these are displayed on the CAC website). Details will be explained fully at the parent meeting and are also listed on the CAC website at www.childadvocacycenter.com. We very much appreciate your agreement to this fundraising effort and want you and your daughter to both know that your efforts will benefit abused and neglected children in our community and will support prevention efforts as well to keep all kids safe. It is through the joint effort of the American Girl committee members, our volunteers, and the fashion show models that we are able to raise money to benefit the Child Advocacy Center.

Finally, there will be a mandatory parent meeting on Monday, December 12, 2011 from 6:00 to 8:00 pm at the Main Library in Downtown Fayetteville, 300 Maiden Lane. Details regarding all model requirements, expectations and benefits will be explained and all questions answered at that time. Please read, sign, and return the enclosed model agreement at the parent meeting.

We would like to thank you in advance for all of your hard work and commitment to the American Girl Fashion Show® benefiting the Child Advocacy Center. We couldn't do it without you! Model Agreement

As a model (and parent of a model) in the American Girl Fashion Show, we agree to the following terms:

1. At least one of my parents will attend the mandatory parent meeting (12/12/11, 6:00 – 8:00 pm @ Headquarters Library, 300 Maiden Lane, Fayetteville) and will return this signed model agreement at that meeting. (It is not necessary for models to attend)
2. I will attend my fashion fitting at the scheduled time. (You will be notified of the date/time in mid-February)
3. I will attend my assigned show rehearsal, which will be scheduled for either March 22, 2012 or March 23, 2012 between 4-9 pm. (You will be notified of the date/time in mid-February)
4. I will arrive for my fashion show, as scheduled and assigned to me by the AGFS committee, at least one hour prior to show time and be ready to go.
5. If an emergency arises which will not allow me to fulfill my agreement, I will notify the AGFS committee as early as possible to allow them time to find a replacement model for me. (emergency contacts for show weekend: Julia Adkins @ 910-978-4597; Carol Jones @ 910-364-5153; Cindy Huguley @ 910-489-0899)
6. I will raise a minimum of \$50.00 in sponsorship fees and sell a minimum of \$50.00 in raffle tickets.
7. I will have all sponsors complete the sponsor information sheet and collect their money at that time.
8. I will have all individuals that purchase raffle tickets complete the information requested on the ticket and I will safely return all raffle tickets to the AGFS committee.
9. I will not solicit sponsorships or sell raffle tickets unless a parent or adult caregiver is with me at all times.
10. I will have my parent(s) turn in all sponsor checks and one personal check for all cash money I raise to the AGFS committee (make check payable to Child Advocacy Center) no later than February 1, 2012.
11. My parent(s) understands that should I not fulfill my full fundraising obligations, it is their responsibility to pay the amount necessary to bring my total funds raised to the \$100.00.
12. My parent(s) understand that in order to watch me model in the show, they must purchase a ticket(s) from the CAC prior to the show date.
13. My mom understands that the AGFS committee needs 4-6 moms volunteering backstage for each show and will let the committee or CAC know if she can help at my show or one of the other shows to be held during the weekend. (All mom-volunteers must remain backstage from before the show starts until it ends and no models or siblings are allowed backstage unless they are modeling in that specific show.) **All backstage volunteers will be required to have a criminal background check.**
14. I will have FUN throughout this entire process and be proud of myself for helping a great cause and giving back to my community!
